Built in 1811, St. Paul's is the oldest church in the Diocese, and until it's closure in 2012, was one of the oldest continuously used churches in Ontario.

With a history of shared use between multiple congregations, St. Paul's was a cornerstone of life in Delta and played an important part in the history and development of the village.

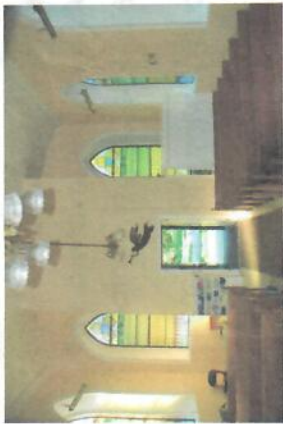
The committee is made up of members of St. Paul's past congregation, as well as residents of Delta and the surrounding area.

The next and larger phase is the restoration of the church hall to include facilities that will provide a permanent home for the Delta food bank, youth activities and community programs. Fundraising events are held throughout the year in support of our project and operating expenses.
